### Criteria for funding:

1. Priority given to current and former players of ESJBA
2. Maximum cap per applicant (£200)
3. i) those of ability do not have the means to meet the fees charged, or
  - ii) those with the ability already have other financial commitment elsewhere.
  - iii) for parents that have personal financial difficulties due to loss of employment or other circumstances that have limited their family income.
  - iv) those on Income Support
  - v) Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
  - vi) Support under part VI of the Immigration and asylum Act 1999
  - vii) Child Tax Credit provided the parent is not entitled to Working Tax Credit and their annual income, assessed by The Inland Revenue, that does not exceed £14,000 (single parent), £18,000 (joint).
  - viii) guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
  - ix) income related employment and support allowance that was introduced on 27 October 2008 and updated April 2018 (Proof required)
  - x) only one application per person per season

All suitable applicants will be reviewed individually based upon their own specific requirements.

The level of award to be agreed by the ESJBA Committee.

The application must include:

- full details of the applicant,
- age,
- gender,
- school etc.,
- intent of expenditure,
- list of costings,
- duration of activity,
- name of club/group,
- Coach(s),
- where the activity will take place
